## TOUR TO POLAND WITH EXTENTION TO DUBROVNIK WITH THE BLAZONCZYK FAMILY - 2020

**July 22/Wed - CHICAGO - WARSAW.** This evening, we board a non stop overnight transatlantic flight for Warsaw with meals and movies on board.

**July 23/Thu- WARSAW.** After arrival in Warsaw, we will be met by our guide who will take us to the hotel in the city center. Time to unpack and change money. Welcome dinner in a local restaurant. (D)

**July 24/Fri - WARSAW.** This morning we introduce you to the highlights of Poland's' heroic capital, largely destroyed during WWII and beautifully rebuilt with great care. Start with the colorful Old Town with picturesque Royal Castle Square, St John's Cathedral and remnants of the defense walls. Then via Royal Route, continue to the beautiful Lazienki Park built in the 18th century. Tour the splendid Wilanow Palace, summer residence of King Sobieski. This evening's dinner is planned in a local restaurant with a folklore performance. (B, D)

**July 25/Sat - WARSAW - Czestochowa - WISLA.** This morning journey south to Czestochowa, pilgrimage center of Poland. Here we tour the Jasna Gora Monastery and the Black Madonna Shrine with its miraculous icon. After lunch continue to Wisla resort, in the rolling Beskidy Mountains. Tonight is the opening of the Festival of Beskid Culture so we can enjoy the performances. (B, L)

**July 26/Sun - WISLA.** After morning Mass, spend the day discovering attractions of this region and get acquainted with the daily life and customs of the local gorale. Lunch in a typical cottage with local specialties. This evening spend the time at the Festival or relax in the Aqua Park and Spa in our hotel. (B, L)

**July 27/Mon- WISLA - ZAKOPANE via Zywiec and Wadowice.** After breakfast depart for the Zywiec Brewery, one of the oldest in Poland. After lunch at the brewery, continue via Wadowice, birthplace of Karol Wojtyla (St. John Paul II) to Zakopane, favorite vacation resort hidden in the Tatra Mountains. Relax for the night in our beautiful brand new hotel and Spa. (B, D)

**July 28/Tue - ZAKOPANE.** Spend another relaxing day in Zakopane and enjoy a nine-mile fun ride on rafts down the Dunajec River in the Pieniny National Park. Return to Zakopane for balance of the day at leisure. (B, L)

**July 29/Wed - ZAKOPANE.** This morning depart for the picturesque village of Chocholow, hometown of the Blazonczyk family, with unique architecture. Stop at the local wood carver's shop. Our stay in Zakopane ends with a picnic where we'll be entertained by the mountaineers, "Gorale," and taste local specialties. (B, D)

**July 30/Thu - ZAKOPANE - KRAKOW.** Leaving the majestic Tatras behind, we journey to the medieval Krakow, a city full of legends and traditions which was spared the destruction of WWII. After check-in at the hotel in heart of the city, we meet a local guide who will introduce us to this unique city. Included is the Royal Castle, from where Polish kings ruled for four centuries. Visit the Wawel Cathedral where Polish kings were crowned and buried. Walk to the Market Square, one of the largest in Europe, with St. Mary's Basilica and the Cloth Hall, dating back to the 14th century where we can shop for souvenirs. (B, L)

**July 31/Fri - KRAKOW.** Today is reserved for an optional excursions to the fascinating underground wonders of the Wieliczka salt mine and to Auschwitz, former Nazi concentration camp, now a martyrdom museum. (B, D)

**August 1/Sat - KRAKOW.** Day free to discover this fascinating city at your own pace. There is so much to see and do. The Market Square is filled with souvenir shops and food vendors. This evening we invite you for a farewell dinner with a folklore show presenting folklore of the Krakow region. (B, D)

**August 2/Sun - KRAKOW - CHICAGO.** This morning, we bid "do widzenia" to our guide and board a non-stop flight home. (B)

### OPTIONAL EXTENSION TO DUBROVNIK

**August 2/Sun - KRAKOW-Warsaw-DUBROVNIK.** This morning depart for the airport and fly to Croatia. Arrive in the afternoon and settle-in at your beautiful resort hotel. Evening is free to get acquainted with your hotel and relax. (B, D)

**August 3/Mon - DUBROVNIK.** After buffet breakfast, meet your local guide who will introduce you to the treasures of this unique city dating back to the 13th century. Enjoy afternoon at leisure. (B, D)

**August 4/Tue - DUBROVNIK.** Early morning depart for the pilgrimage center of Medjugorje (82 miles) where Virgin Mary apparently first appeared in 1981. Continue to nearby Mostar which once connected Europe with the Moslem world. (B, L)

**August 5/Wed - DUBROVNIK-Warsaw-CHICAGO.** After breakfast depart for the airport. (B)

### TOUR CONDITIONS:

**RESERVATIONS/PAYMENTS:** A deposit of \$200 per person is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due on or before June 1, 2020. The price of the tour includes a built-in discount of 2% for payment by cash or check. There is no discount on credit card sales.
